Easy and Colourful - Block Lotto for September

This block is very easy and quick to make. <u>Because</u> - you are all busy creating your Birthday surprise quilt, I hope you can squeeze in a half hour for this one.

Colour choice is from the July MQG colour chart. Use 1 solid and white.

(Tone on tone is acceptable as long as it reads as a solid)

The strips are 2½" and may be cut WOF, or from a fat quarter, or from a scrap.

Cut: 5 strips from the coloured fabric, 2½" x 6½". 3 strips white, 2½" x 4½" and 4 white, 2½" squares.

Finishes at 101/2".

1 Block = 1 Ticket Feel free to make lots. It is so quick and so much fun to use the whole crayon box!

HINT: use a mat to arrange the pieces and stitch in the order laid out as there is a sequence.



This block has five cuts from your 10" piece of fabric: (5) 2.5" x 6.5". From background fabric, each block needs (3) 2.5" x 4.5" and (4) 2.5" x 2.5".
