

## POINTY THINGS!

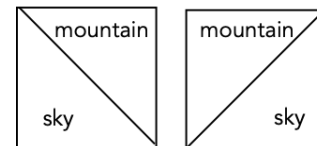
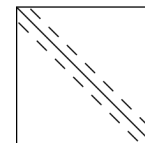
This project uses the Delectable Mountains traditional block.

Colour scheme: white and blue (solid or printed)

Guidelines: Use accurate ¼" seams

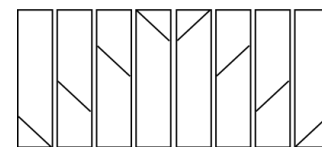


1. Cut one white (mountain) and one blue (sky) block, 10" square each. Lay on your table top, right sides together. Mark a diagonal line from one corner to the other in the white block. Stitch a ¼" on each side of the line.
2. Cut along the line. Press these seams open and clip off only the excess fabric points. Do not trim the block. (Note: you are making 2 big half square triangles.)
3. This gives you two blocks. Lay them on your cutting mat so they are opposing.
4. Measure your square and cut each into 4 equal strips. I find 2¾" wide seems to be right. Repeat with the other half square triangle. Arrange, side by side on a small cutting mat - you will be carrying this mat to your sewing machine.



*Fun Part! I love easy blocks that get cut up and rearranged into something completely different.*

5. While the strips are lying flat on your mat, turn strips around end to end (180°), keeping them in order. You will see your pointy shapes appear. Stitch each set of strips together with accurate ¼" seams. Do not stitch the centre seam.
6. Press. Each block will measure 8" by 9½". You will have two. The winner of the Block Lotto will want to mix and match these.
