
Mid Century Modern - Block Lotto - February 2025

Inspired by projects previously done at our guild and by the Royal BC Museum exhibit - 'Canadiana Modern', this is a block that is both scrappy and confined to angular straight seams.

Fire up your iron, make sure your cutting tool has a good blade, and explore your stash for a bit of white, a bit of orange, a bit more of turquoise, and a good grey. Examine your collection to make sure they look good together. These may be solids or tone-ontones, however it is best if they have a modern aesthetic. (No batiks or 90's florals please)

- 1. Begin with a white square that is angular and about 4" square.
- 2. Add an angular strips to each side, using a mixture of orange, turquoise and white fabrics. This is a modified log cabin or courthouse steps technique. Some strips should have a bit of an angle to keep it interesting. Diagram shows suggested piecing.



- 3. Guildelines for success:
 - Seams are always straight, never curved.
 - Press often, after every seam is stitched.
 - Trim often use a ruler and cutting tool so that the seams remain straight.
- 4. The strips you add may be skinny or wide. Variety is essential. However, don't make them too small or you will be adding endless rows. Large chunks work well.
- 5. The final border is light grey. Square up to $12\frac{1}{2}$ " to receive 1 ticket.
