


Selvedge Block




1) Start with a piece of tearaway stabilizer, or a stable base fabric, 13" square. Draw a line corner to corner, then draw a series of lines parallel to your first.





2) Place your first piece in one of the corners. Add a second piece selvedge edge overlapping the first piece, making sure to keep the pieces straight with the lines you drew. Stitch close to the edge to secure pieces together.





3) Ensure the entire piece is covered with selvedges. If you used tearaway, remove stabilizer. Trim to 12.5" square. Make sure the diagonal is still corner to corner 45°.
