

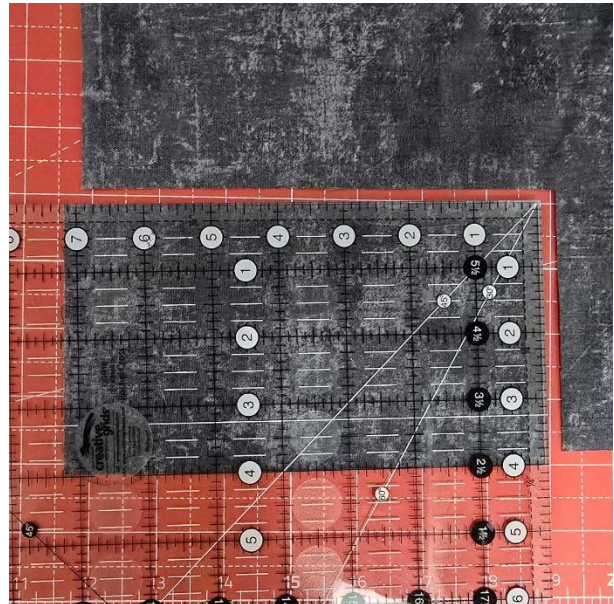
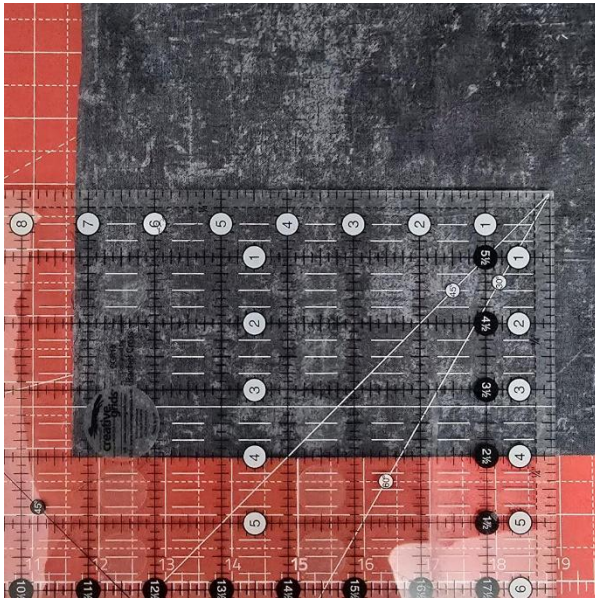
Argyle Quilt Block

Pick one colour family for your block. This is a great use of scraps. Select **twelve different fabrics** that are at least 4x7" : **4x light, 4x medium, and 4x dark**. We will be making them into 4" 60-degree diamonds.

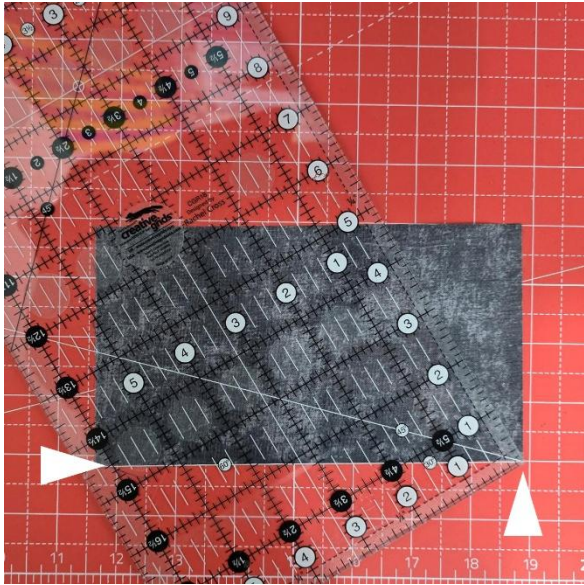
Highly recommend using ironing spray to stabilize your fabrics before cutting. We will be working on the bias for assembly.

Cutting a 4" 60° Diamond:

Cut your piece of fabric into a 4" strip first. It needs to be at least 7" long to fit the finished diamond.

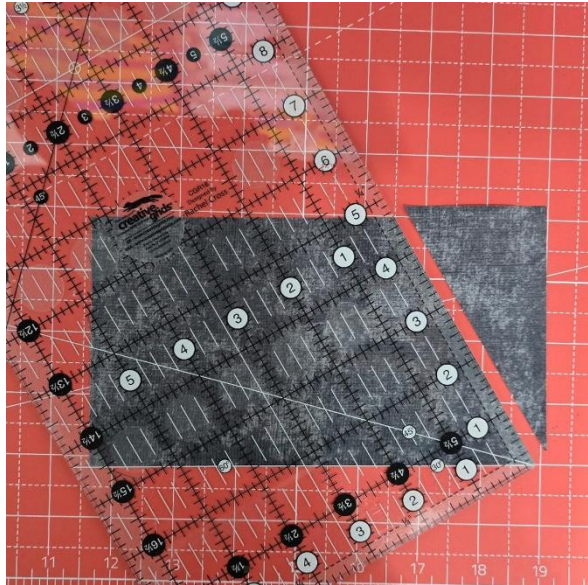


Then line up the ruler on the fabric strip with the 60° line along the bottom edge of the strip and the end of the ruler is at the corner of the strip. Trim off end.



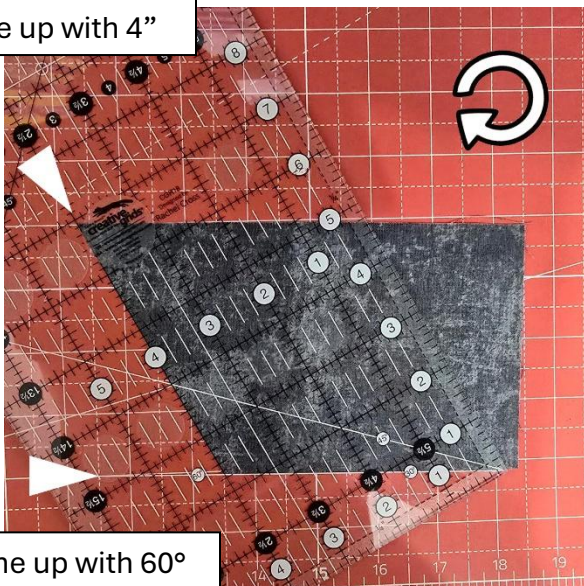
Line up with 60°

Ruler at corner

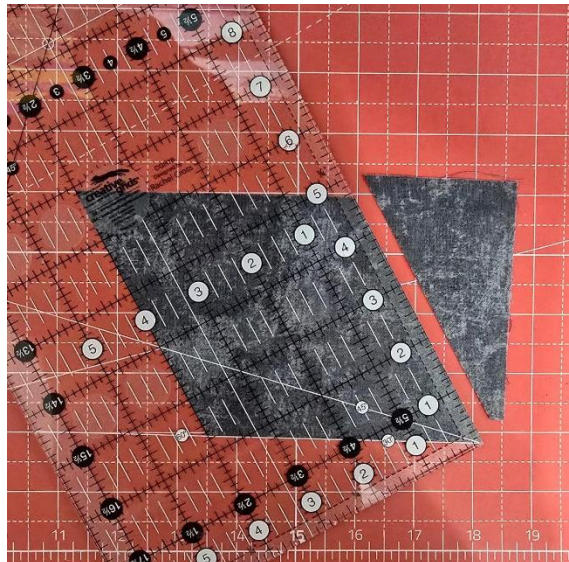


Flip your fabric around so that we are cutting on the opposite side. Again, line the ruler on the fabric strip with the 60° line along the bottom edge of the strip, sliding it down until the other angled side lines up with the 4" line. Trim off end.

Line up with 4"



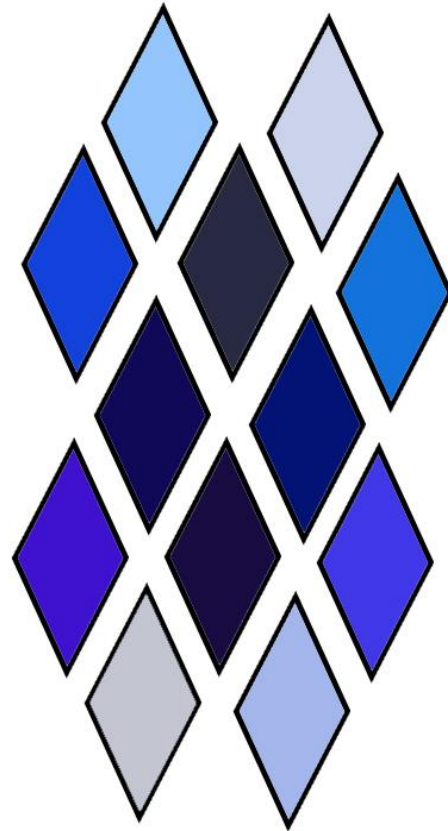
Line up with 60°



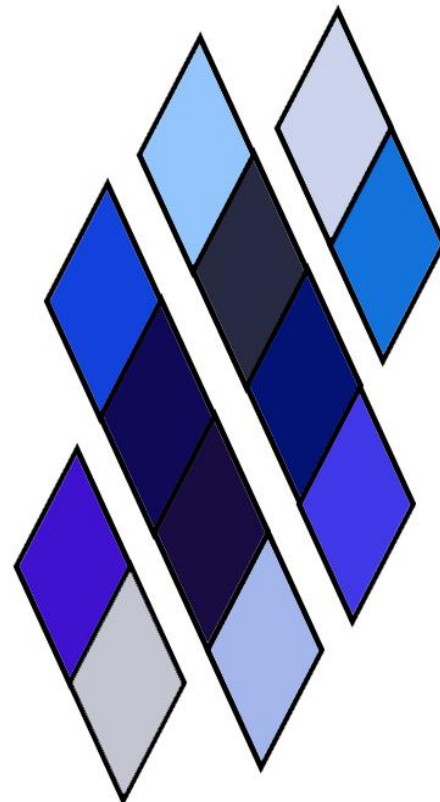
Assembly:

Arrange your diamonds so that:

- 4 dark diamonds are in the middle
- 2 medium diamonds are at each side
- 2 light diamonds are at the top and 2 are at the bottom



Join your diamonds in diagonal rows



Join the rows together,
taking care to join the
seams



Trim your block to 8.5”
wide and 14.5” tall
