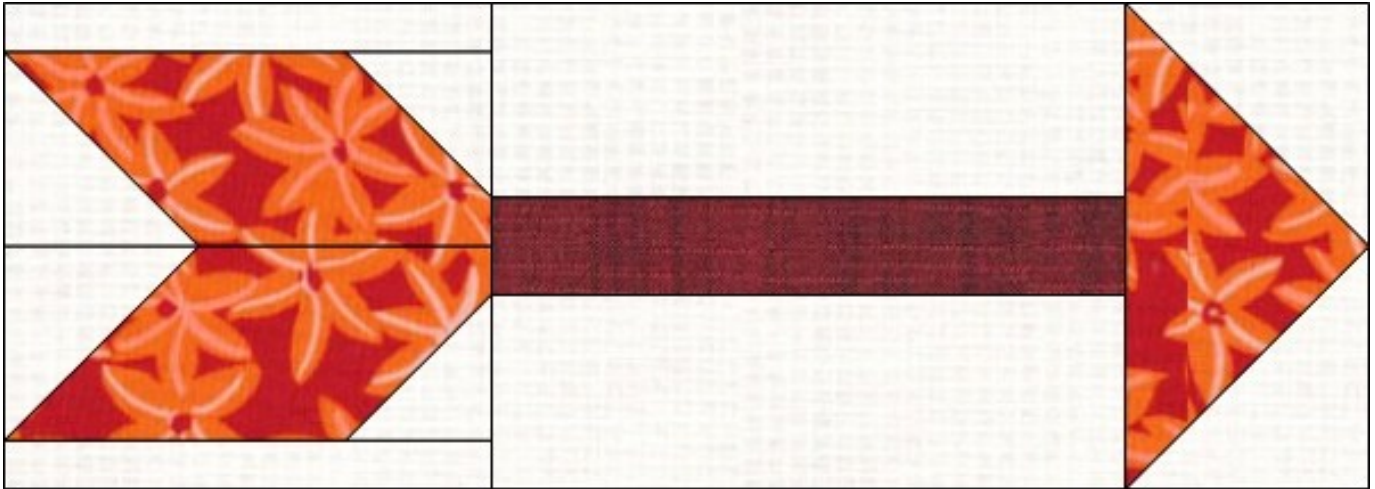

# ARROW



Fabric needed:

Arrowhead and Feathers:

2@ 5.5"x2.5" rectangles for feathers

1@ 5.5" x 3" rectangle for Arrowhead

Shaft:

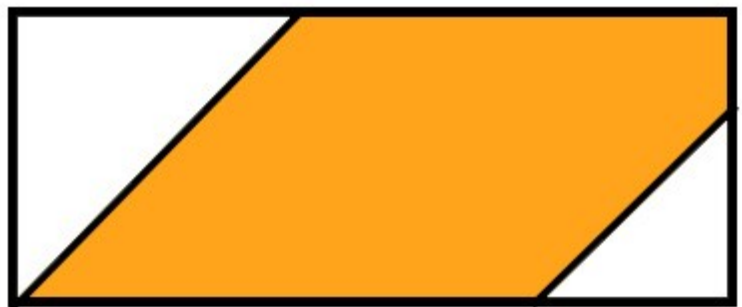
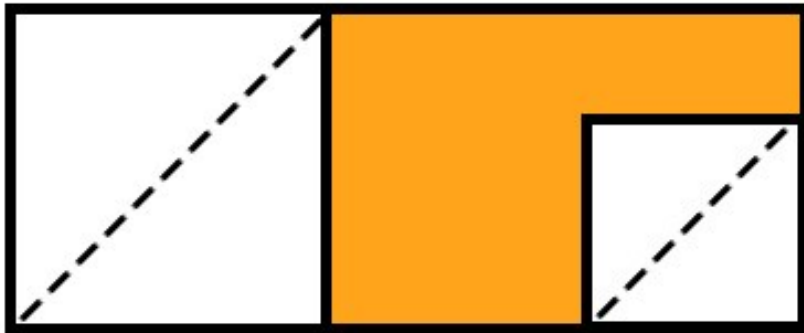
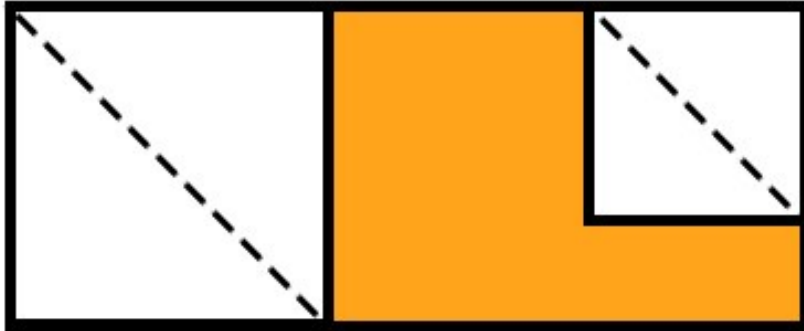
1@ 1.5" strip at length of your choice

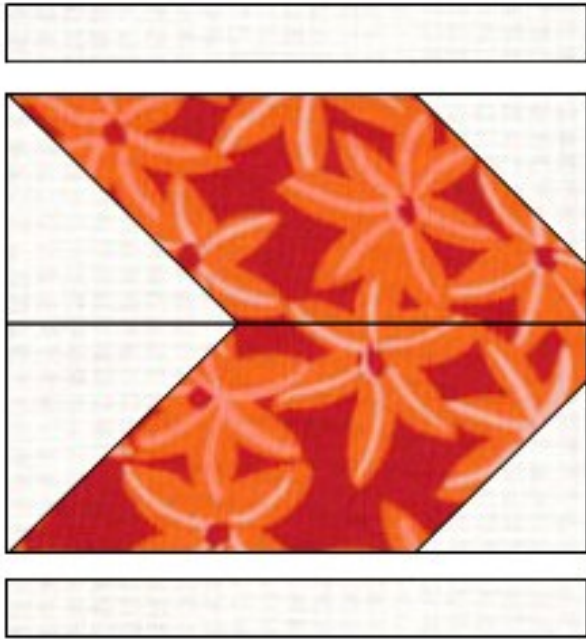
Background:

White, Fat Quarter, or scraps.

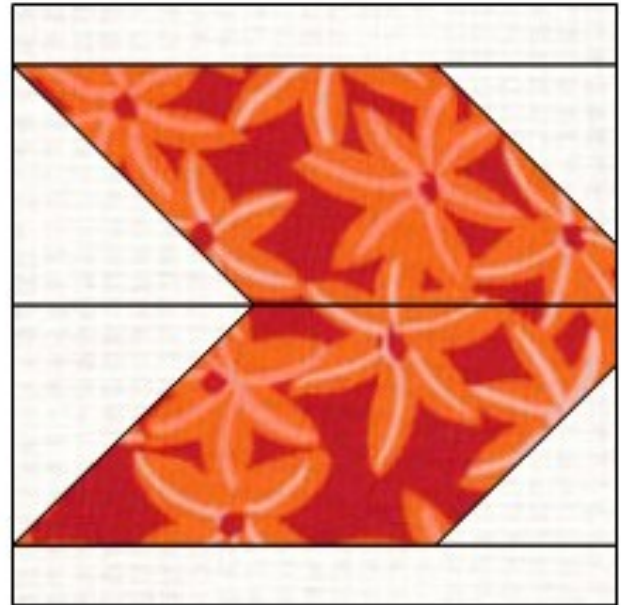
Keep colours bright and bold. Try to keep shaft patterns simple (tone on tone), but have fun with arrowhead and feather colours/patterns.

Take two feather rectangles, 5.5"x2.5". Cut two 2" squares and two 2.5" squares from white background. Place as shown in picture below, ensuring each feather is opposite from the other. Stitch corner to corner. Trim excess and flip the white out toward the cor-

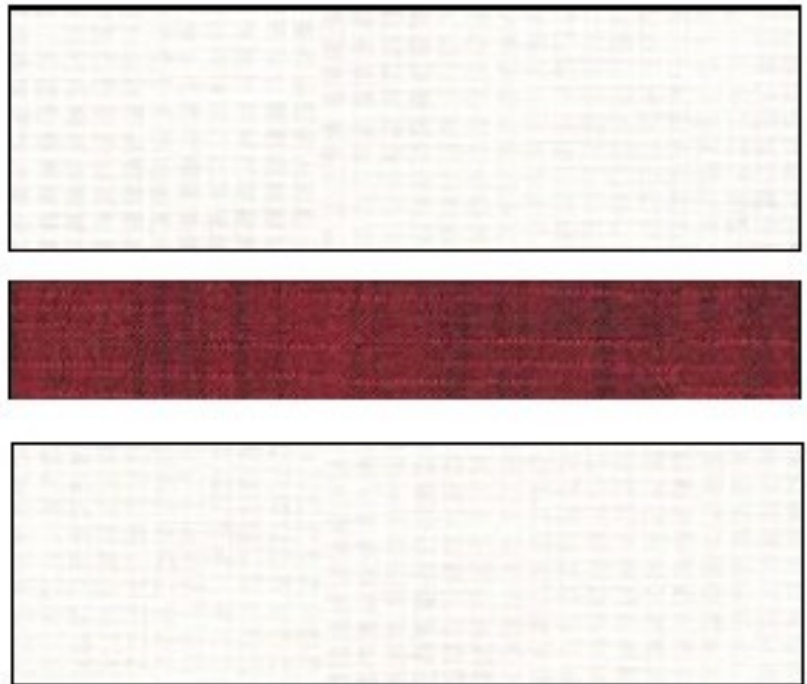




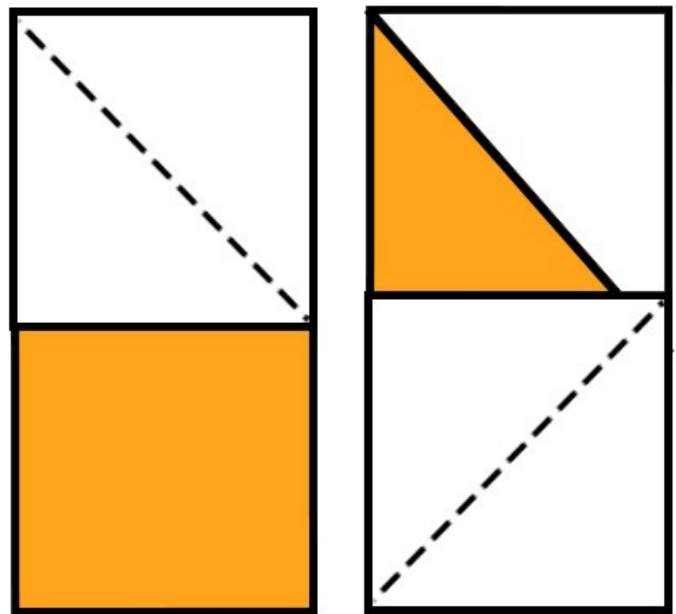
Join two halves of feathers together, then add a strip of background white to the outer edges, each 5.5"x1".



In whatever length you choose, combine a 1.5" strip of shaft colour with two 2.5" strips of background white, one on either side.



Make a flying goose for the arrowhead. You can use the same stitch **and** flip method as the feathers by cutting two 3" squares of the white background. Place one on your 3x5.5" arrowhead fabric and stitch corner to corner. Trim off excess and flip the background fabric up. Repeat on the other side.



Now it's time to assemble the three pieces. Join feathers to shaft to arrowhead.
