

# Block Lotto

## Stack-N-Whack Charms



This is a stack-n-whack style of block, in which blocks are made in pairs. For two blocks, you need:

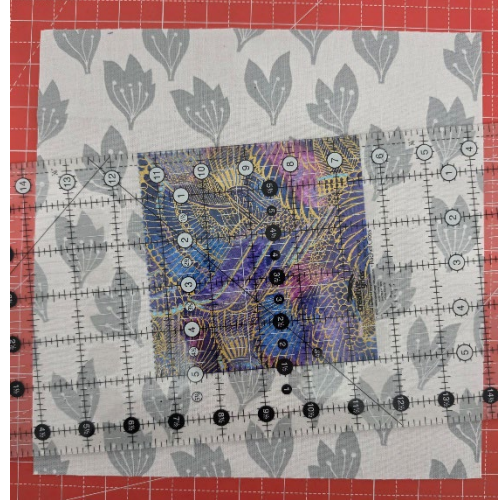
- 2x Coloured charm square (5” square)
- 2x Low volume layer cake square (10” square)
- 2x Black(ish) 1.5” x 10” strip

Note: If you select different coloured charm squares and different coloured low volume layer cake squares, you end up with a more random look.

- 1) Take your two 10” squares and stack them right sides up carefully on top of one another. Place one of the 5” squares mainly centered, but somewhat askew.



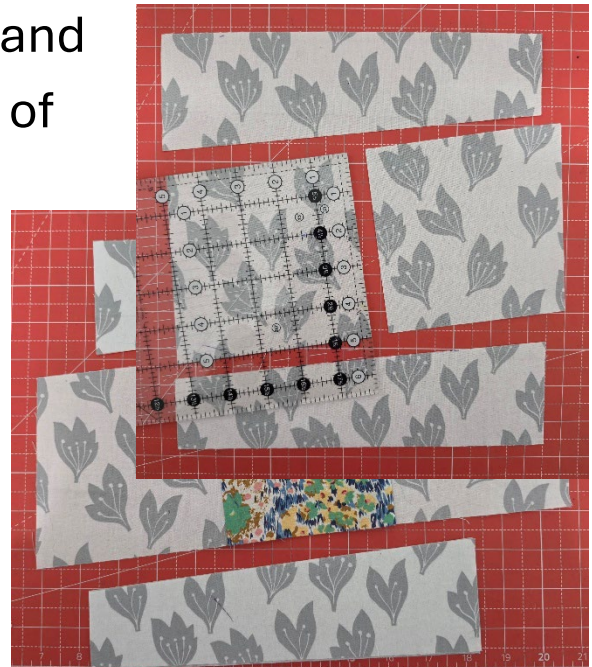
2) Line your ruler up with the top edge of the 5" square and cut across the two 10" squares.



3) Repeat for the bottom edge of the 5" square.



4) Remove the 5" square and cut the middle section of the 2 background 10" squares in half, so that the cut is square with the previous two cuts. (See ruler positioning.)



5) For each background, join the two middle pieces to the sides of one of the 5" squares.

6) Stack the two blocks back on top of one another again, as close as possible.



7) Slice across both blocks one more time.



8) Mix

and match the two pairs.



- 9) Place one of the black strips in the middle of each of the two block pairs and line them up as centered as can be.



- 10) Join them together. It's totally okay if the squares don't line up, as long as you can square the whole thing up to 9"



11) Square up your blocks to 9”.



12) Repeat as many times as you like, playing with your angles. Have fun!
